




DPS COVID-19 DASHBOARD

The purpose of this dashboard is to provide our Dartmouth Public School families and employees with current data and a summary of COVID-19 cases by school resulting in exclusion from in-person learning.

An active case indicates that a student or employee participating in-person learning has tested positive for an active COVID-19 infection. Individuals who test positive are excluded from any in-person learning until the district verifies that the individual meeting the return criteria set by state and local health authorities. Once the individual is cleared to return they are no longer considered an active case. The case is then transferred to the resolved cases column.

DASHBOARD DEFINITIONS

 ACTIVE A student or employee participating in-person learning has tested positive for an active COVID-19 infection and is currently in a 10-day isolation.	 PERCENTAGE The number of active student cases in relation to the number of students and employees on site. (Active Student Cases/Total Students)	 RESOLVED The "active" individual has completed the 10-day isolation and is cleared to return to in-person learning. Their case is moved from the "active" count on the dashboard to the "resolved" count.

Isolation:
Separates people testing positive from people who are not sick.



Quarantine:
Separates and restricts the movement of people who have been exposed by a person testing positive to see if they become sick.



Stay-At-Home:
Individuals who show one or more symptoms should stay home until symptoms subside & are encouraged to get tested.

Dartmouth Public Schools continues to follow Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and Department of Public Health Guidelines. The process for parent/guardian and employee notification is as follows:

If there are individuals who had close contact with the person who has been confirmed with a positive case of COVID-19, they will be notified by phone from the Dartmouth Board of Health. The school community will receive an email from their building principal stating that there was a positive case at the school.

The district is bound by FERPA, HIPPA and ADA regulations regarding the release of specific health information.
